He is thin.

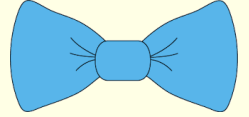

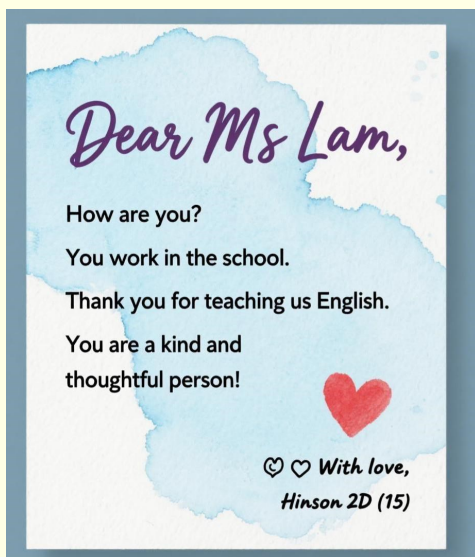


Picnic Day (2E) Cheng Sin Ki, Kiki

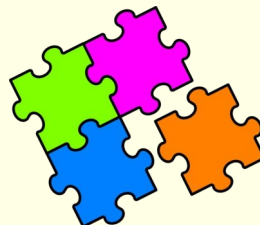
Hi Alan,

I attended a two-day biology interest course at an AI academy designed for students from sixth grade to the first year of high school.

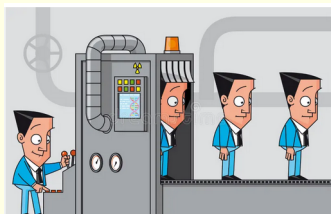
