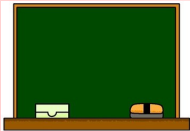

I like apples best.

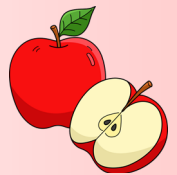

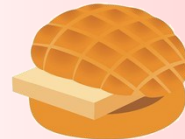
My Magical Bakery (3D) Yau Ming Ngai, Johnny
