Tina is in the park.

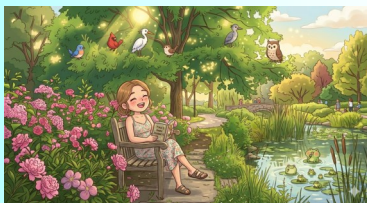
She can smell the beautiful flowers.

My Favourite Season (2E) Yannes

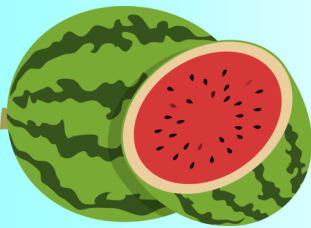
It is hot and sunny.

A Lucky Day (5B) Man

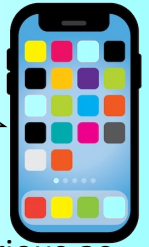


This morning, I went to the supermarket to buy some groceries. I thought about crossing the road but I saw the pedestrian light was red, so I waited until the light was green.
